General Arrangement

Access the main cabin from the cockpit through a large sliding glass door. Immediately to port is a U-shaped dinette & across is the ship's diesel heater mounted on the aft bulkhead. Forward to port is the L-shaped galley. Along the forward companionway to starboard is the owner's stateroom with double berth and ship's head with stall shower. The pilothouse has a portside settee and portside dutch door to access sidedecks. Starboard of the lower helm is the ladder leading down to the foc'sle with double berth and two single bunks. Amidship on the lower deck is the engine room & generator. A large storage compartment housing ship's batteries is accessed through the salon sole. Port & starboard sidedeck stairs lead up to the flybridge with centreline helm and a large dinghy storage area. There is a ladder from the flybridge down to the cockpit.

Salon & Galley

Large port & starboard windows, two white wicker arm chairs, u-shaped dinette and the diesel heater are located in the salon area. The dinette will seat four comfortably. The galley has a large window for natural lighting & good visibility. She's equipped with 3-burner Force 10 propane stove & oven, double stainless steel sinks, 12 & 110 volt Norcold refrigerator, microwave & pressurized hot & cold water.
